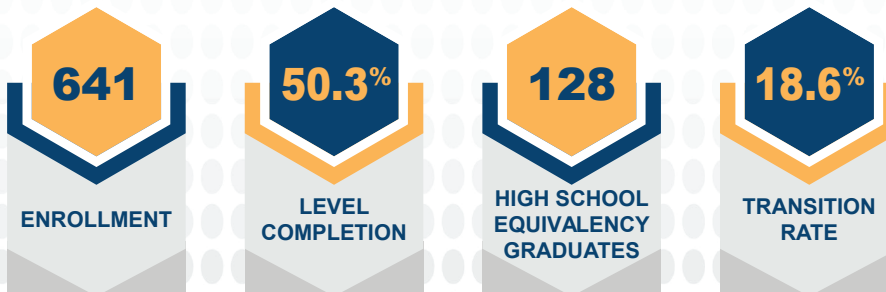

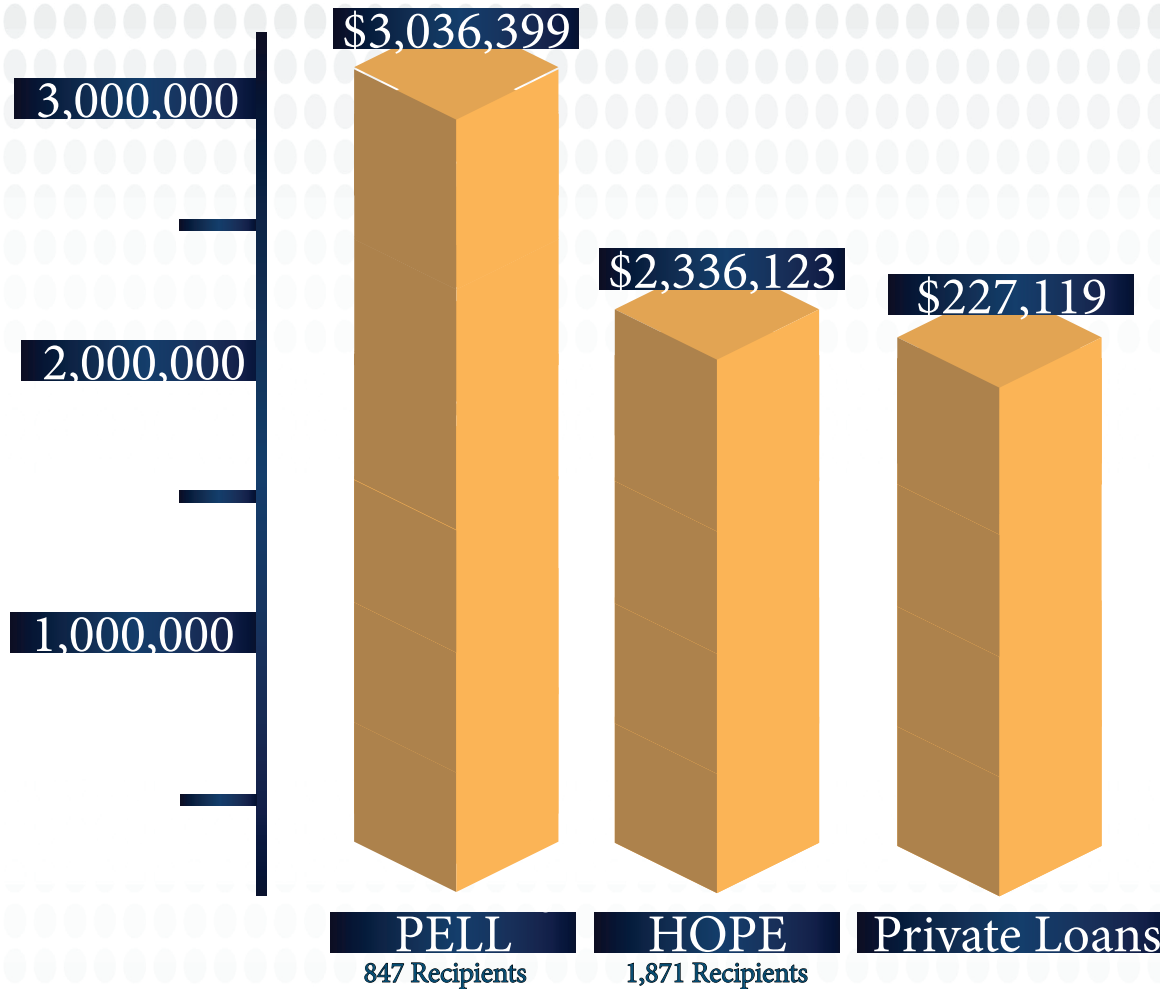

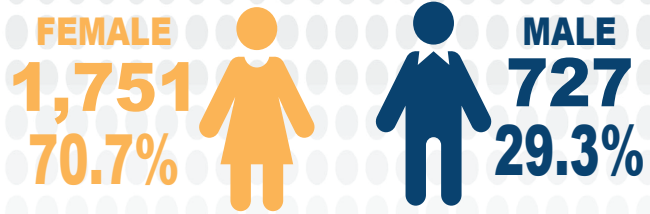

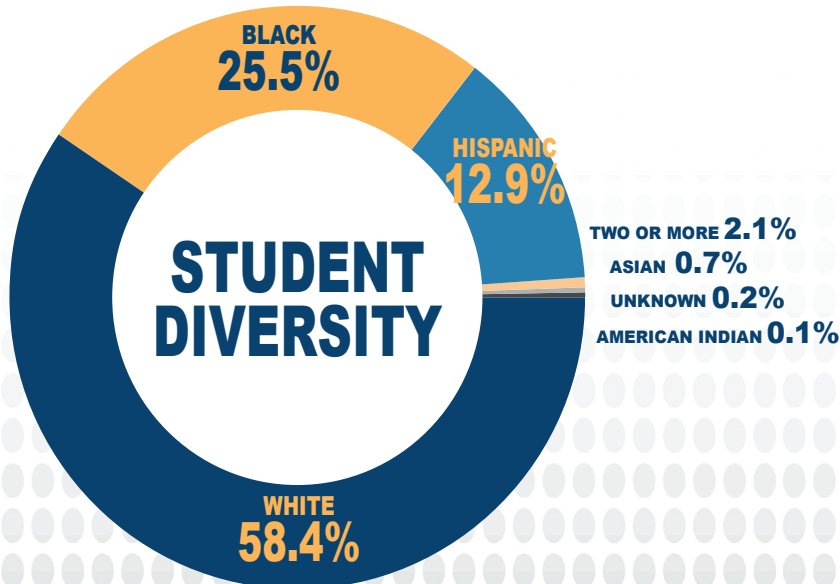

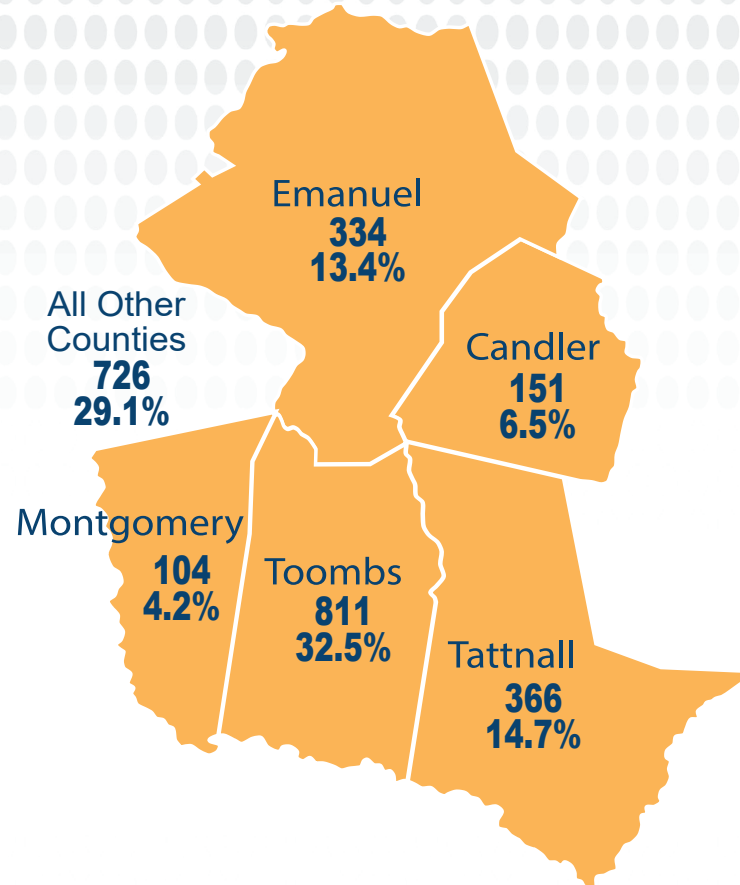
STUDENTS BY GENDER



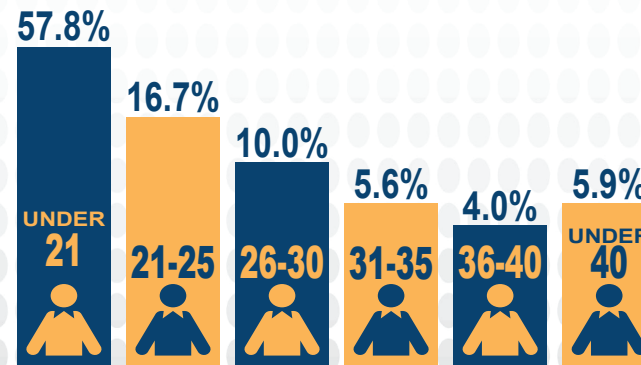
STUDENTS BY GENDER

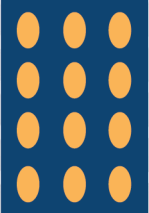

MOU WITH HYUNDAI MOTOR GROUP

Southeastern Technical College and Hyundai Motor Group Metaplant of America signed a Memorandum of Understanding for a training partnership that will lead to automotive industry jobs at the metaplant location in Bryan County. The course will be available at Southeastern Tech's Vidalia campus.

The Electric Vehicle Professional Technical Certificate program was created to prepare students for entry-level employment in the electric vehicle production industry. The eight-credit-hour certificate includes three courses and will focus on safe and effective automotive shop operations, automotive electrical principles, and the operation and service of electric vehicles. Those who complete the certificate program will have the skills needed to work in sub-assembly shops, building components, and on the production floor to manufacture electric vehicles.

HMGMA is Hyundai Motor Group's first dedicated electric vehicle mass-production plant. The plant is under construction and is expected to produce 300,000 to 500,000 electric vehicles annually.



The Adult Education program at Southeastern Tech provides students the opportunity to receive a High School Equivalency (HSE). From the most basic studies to English as a Second Language, the Adult Education program serves a variety of students at various levels.

STC Adult Education has an eight-county service area with centers in Glennville, Metter, Millen, Mount Vernon, Reidsville, Soperton, Swainsboro, Vidalia, and Wrightsville. Classes are at no charge to students.

Mobile testing is available to take High School Equivalency testing into the service areas for students who lack transportation to the Swainsboro or Vidalia testing sites.

The Adult Education Department provides HSE testing to several state prisons.

The Adult Education program at Southeastern Tech also provides students the opportunity to participate in Integrated Education and Training Programs (IET) while earning their HSE.

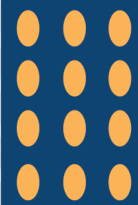
